

Landscape diamond card

Ingredients:

A4 card

Backing papers

Toppers

Tools:

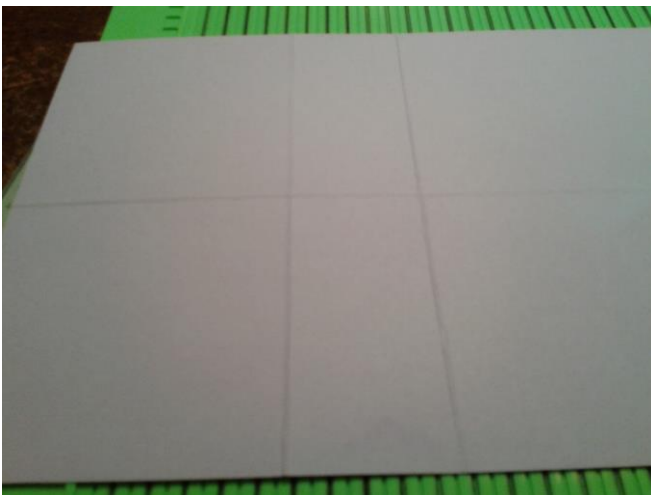
Score tool

Ruler, pencil

Take an A4 piece of card and score in half at 10.5cm along the short edge to make a long, narrow card.



Turn the card round and score along the long edge at 10.5cm and 15.5cm.



Now score from the 10.5 line to the centre crease of the 15.5 line and then from the centre crease of the 15.5 to the bottom of the 10.5 line.



I find it easier to fold the card if you fold each crease backwards and forwards.

All the folds should be valley folds except the 2 diagonal ones and the centre fold on the right side of the card which need to be mountain folds.

The easiest way to fold the card is to make sure the diagonal folds are lifted upwards.



Gently push the right side of the card upwards and give the creases another run over with the score tool.



Lift the card up keeping the card creased this way then gently push the left side in and finish with the diamond on the left side.



Now you can decorate with papers, the diamond should be 10.5 x 10.5 which makes this easy to mat and layer.



Finish with toppers/embellishments
